





Tenant highlight of Success.

I grew up in poverty, and I remember as a child my biggest worry was if I would have food the next day. My parents tried but they faced many hardships. As I got older I always thought about college but by this time I was twenty-one and had two kids. I could barely provide for them or pay the bills, and faced many evictions. I knew I was following the same cycle my parents once lived. I was surviving off benefits and handouts. One day I just decided I had enough. I walked into Baker College, and enrolled in the BSN RN program. Although my journey was hard and I spent most of my nights crying at the table doubting myself, I persevered. I didn't grow up like my peers. I had to work harder than most but I never gave up. A lot of people told me I would never make it but I refused to allow that to deter me. I now have my RN license, and work in Neuro ICU. My journey wasn't easy but one choice, and my determination to finish set me on this path to success. I am sharing my story because I want other people to know you don't have to just survive. You are not the stereotypes people use to label you. You can thrive in life, and achieve your dreams. It just starts with one choice.
